

# Greening Koorda—Information Sessions on NRM Issues Affecting Our Area.



The Koorda Community Resource Centre (CRC) worked in conjunction with the Koorda Primary School to raise awareness of salinity and soil conditions, water pH, varieties of vegetation that are suited to Koorda through information sessions at the school and excursions to out of town locations to plant trees. To fund this venture they applied to Wheatbelt NRM in 2011 for a Small Community Grant.

Koorda is a drought affected area and the trees planted in the past year have had a very low survival rate. The school replanted trees that forms the town's historical walk. This provided not only an opportunity for students to learn of NRM issues facing the area, but also provide a brief look into the town's history.

The Shire of Koorda new potti putkis and kidney buckets were used by the students and the

Community members to plant the trees. Lisa Clark ran NRM information sessions for the school, empowering a partnership between the Koorda Primary School, the Koorda Shire and the Koorda CRC.
